Queries	GIZ'S Response
1. Referring to Chapter 2 - Task 2 in the ToR, can the entire training material be prepared / developed in Gujarati language?	It is advised to prepare presentation slides in English, as some of the participants may have problem reading Gujarati. Rest content can be prepared in Gujarati Language. Also, the training needs to be delivered in Gujarati language.
2. Referring to Chapter 2 - Task 2 - Table of tools in the ToR, a) We do have most of the equipment given in list with us, however, the make is different with equivalent features and the purpose of demonstrating the tool usage will be fulfilled as expected. Are the same equipment of different make ok?	Yes, the same equipment of different make can be used. Consultant must make sure that the purpose of using that tool mentioned under table of tools (under Chapter 2 - Task 2) is fulfilled.
b) Regarding tool No. 6 - SunEye 210 for Shadow Analysis, we will try to arrange for the same, as it may not be available with most of the Institutes across India from where this can be rented. Also, procurement of the same may not be possible within the project timeline due to the COVID situation as this item will arrive from outside India. We do have a Sun Path Finder at our organization which serves the same purpose of Shadow Analysis as that of a SunEye. Can SunEye be replaced by Sun Path Finder for the training purpose?	SunEye 210 has advantage of being handy and digital over Sun path finder and GUVNL must be using SunEye 210 in the field. In case consultant is unable to arrange SunEye until training content is finalised (8 weeks from start date), Sunpath finder can be used instead of SunEye for the training purpose. Consultant must put efforts in arranging SunEye 210 before the starting of the trainings.
3. In the document "Bidding Conditions" (on page 3 and 4), the name of this Tender is appearing to be different as compared to all other tender documents and is a bit confusing. Please clarify.	The same has been corrected and new "bidding conditions" doc has been uploaded for all future references.
